

Coastline Beauty College – Self-Monitoring Policy (5, CCR §71760)

Coastline Beauty College makes every effort to comply with the current policies and procedures enacted and required by the California Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (BPPE). Coastline Beauty College informs students, staff, and faculty, of these policies and procedures.

The Financial Aid Director regularly reviews pertinent BPPE laws and regulations that affect the operations of the school. These include the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009, SB Bill 1192, Student Tuition Recovery Fund, Title 5, Division 7.5 California Code of Regulations, and Disciplinary Guidelines. Copies of these documents are maintained in the Director's office.

At least once per year, the Financial Aid Director meets with staff members and instructors to review current BPPE policies and procedures and to highlight any changes. If regulatory changes necessitate adjustment to School operational procedures or documentation, these will be implemented and, if applicable, published in a revised version of the School Catalog.

In instances where BPPE policies and procedures changes must be implemented before the publication of a new catalog, the School will inform staff, students, and faculty, by posting in classrooms and breakrooms, and through verbal announcement during class.
